Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) No WiMax equipment in the band 3300-3650 MHz will be offered for sales in the United States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, and the Territories and Possessions (USP).
- (4) No equipment shall be developed in this band for use in the USP since it is a federal government band for radiolocation. Any development for use in the USP needs to be done in an approved FCC band. WiMax should not be developed in the band 3300-3650 MHz for sales in the USP.
- (5) Proxim, Inc., needs to be aware of possible interference from high power government radars in the band 3300-3650 MHz.
- (6) This authorization is for equipment that is intended for export only.
- (7) Licensee should be aware that US Air Force operations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
