Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 12 2013, PureWave Networks Inc. (PureWave), a manufacturer of Long Term Evolution (LTE) equipment, obtained Special Temporary Authority (STA) from the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) to conduct temporary testing of its products on Band Class 14 through January 1, 2014. BayRICS supported that STA request in a letter to the Commission dated May 21, 2013.

PureWave now seeks to extend the STA for six months to conduct additional testing. BayRICS supports PureWave's request for this extension. PureWave has coordinated with BayRICS on its test results to date, and we anticipate that the continued testing proposed under this extension will generate additional information beneficial to public safety.

Subject to any additional approvals required by FirstNet, BayRICS has determined that PureWave's limited and temporary testing will not cause any interference with BayRICS deployments or use of Band Class 14 spectrum in the BayRICS geographic area.
