This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Operation will be confined to three sites in Santa Clara, California. PureWave would test three temporary base stations, together with no more than five computer modules, five end-users devices and a wireless router, all within a 30-mile radius of each site.
- (3) Request to operate in the 758-768 and 788-798 MHz bands was prior coordinated with First Responder Network Authority ("FirstNet").
- (4) Operation will occur no longer than 180 days from the date on which the FCC grants PureWave an Experimental STA, allowing time during that period for setup and testing, demonstrations, and teardown.
- (5) Operation must not interfere or create a significant potential for harmful interference with any public safety operations in the 700 MHz band.

Special Conditions:

- (6) Operation of the experimental STA will not be used in mission-critical operations or in the delivery of live transmissions in duties to protect life, property, or safety. Operations will be confined to a 30-mile radius of each base station location.
- (7) This Experimental STA is non-renewable and any Experimental ST A use of radio frequencies licensed to FirstNet beyond the 180-day period to which this application refers must be made by a separate request for such use by PureWave.
- (8) PureWave understands that an experimental license only permits shared use of the subject radio frequencies and that it may have to coordinate with other entities licensed for experimental purposes.
