QUALCOMM Incorporated ("QUALCOMM") hereby submits the following information in connection with its request for expedited approval of its STA application 0097-EX-ST-2007, which was submitted on February 14, 2007. The purpose of the STA is to support a demonstration of QUALCOMM's innovative MediaFLO technology, for which homeland security and intelligence agencies have expressed strong interest, at the annual meeting of QUALCOMM's stockholders, which will occur on March 13th, 2007 at the Copley Symphony Hall in San Diego.

Homeland security and intelligence agencies have expressed strong interest in the MediaFLO technology to be demonstrated at the upcoming meeting,. Recently, the National Security Agency (NSA) conducted a study to determine how MediaFLO could be used to disseminate intelligence information. NSA, in partnership with the Intelligence and Homeland Security Communities, has determined that MediaFLO can be a critical tool to deliver valuable information and intelligence in any format (text, audio, video, multimedia) to decision makers and field employees nationwide, initially at the Sensitive But Unclassified level. QUALCOMM is working with the Director of Information Assurance at NSA, the Department of Homeland Security (including FEMA and other agencies within the Department of Homeland Security), as well as the Chief Information Officer of the National Intelligence Directorate to begin the testing and use of the MediaFLO technology to transmit homeland security and intelligence information.

Accordingly, grant of the instant STA request will enable QUALCOMM to demonstrate its MediaFLO technology, for which homeland security and intelligence agencies have expressed strong interest. These agencies recognize that the MediaFLO technology to be demonstrated has the potential to substantially enhance the nation's defense and homeland security. A point of contact is Mr. Richard C.
