QUALCOMM Incorporated ("QUALCOMM") hereby submits the following information in connection with its request for expedited approval of its STA application 0323-EX-ST-2007, which was submitted on June 15th, 2007. The purpose of the STA is to support further development of QUALCOMM's innovative MediaFLO technology, for which homeland security and intelligence agencies have expressed strong interest.

Homeland security and intelligence agencies have expressed strong interest in the MediaFLO technology which is the subject of the STA application. Recently, the National Security Agency (NSA) conducted a study to determine how MediaFLO could be used to disseminate intelligence information. NSA, in partnership with the Intelligence and Homeland Security Communities, has determined that MediaFLO can be a critical tool to deliver valuable information and intelligence in any format (text, audio, video, multimedia) to decision makers and field employees nationwide, initially at the Sensitive But Unclassified level. QUALCOMM is working with the Director of Information Assurance at NSA and the Department of Homeland Security Office of Science and Technology to begin the testing and use of the MediaFLO technology to transmit homeland and national security information.

Accordingly, grant of the instant STA request will enable QUALCOMM to refine further its MediaFLO technology for which homeland security and intelligence agencies have expressed strong interest. These agencies recognize that the MediaFLO technology to be demonstrated has the potential to substantially enhance the nation's defense and homeland security. A point of contact is Mr. Richard C.
