QUALCOMM Incorporated, ("QUALCOMM") hereby applies for authority to operate experimental facilities in the Domestic Public Cellular Radio Telecommunications Service bands (824-849 MHz and 869-894 MHz). On September 3, 1994, the Commission granted QUALCOMM Special Temporary Authority to operate facilities anywhere in the continental United States in these bands. I have attached a copy of the STA and QUALCOMM's STA application as Exhibit 2 to the present experimental application.

Since the grant of the STA, the United States National Security Agency ("NSA") has awarded QUALCOMM a contract to demonstrate that QUALCOMM's CDMA Cellular system can provide certain features of interest to U.S. Government Agencies. QUALCOMM needs an experimental authorization to perform testing in support of this contract.

In addition, QUALCOMM is continuing the testing and system demonstrations that it described in the above referenced STA request.

For these reasons QUALCOMM requests that the Commission convert its existing STA authority to a two year experimental authorization.
