Re: Consent to Modify Experimental
Station WD2XLG, San Diego, CA

Dear Ms. McCarthy:

I am writing in response to your letter of December 19th to Jeremy Howard seeking KCET's consent to modify Qualcomm's experimental license in San Diego to operate two low-power directionalized MediaFLO transmitters on Channel 59.

As you know, KCET has asked Dane Ericksen of the Consulting Engineering firm of Hammett & Edison to review your proposal to determine whether it will cause interference to Station KCET-DT. A copy of his report is attached. As that report indicates, he advises that operation of the two facilities you propose should not result in any harmful interference to KCET-DT if your application is modified to conform to the updated data you provided him. In light of that advice, KCET hereby consents to the grant of your application on the condition that you modify your application in the following respects:

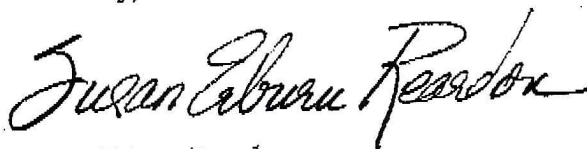
1. The Sandi 1 transmitter employs an antenna orientation of 60°T and the main beam ERP is 100 watts.
2. The Sandi 2 transmitter employs a directional CL-1469 transmitting antenna with an antenna orientation of 220°T and the main beam ERP is 100 watts.
3. Both antennas employ only vertical polarization.

In granting its consent, KCET is not waiving any rights it might have under the FCC's rules to request that Qualcomm cease operation of these experimental facilities if harmful interference is in fact caused to KCET-DT. This consent is also conditioned on Qualcomm's working cooperatively with KCET to determine at Qualcomm's expense whether any interference a viewer might receive is caused by the operation of the facilities Qualcomm is proposing to construction.
