Please find responses to your questions below:

1. Location of tablets in the U.S.

[Qualcomm] The tablets can be located anywhere within the United States.

2. Clarify controlled user environment (i.e., indoor, outdoor, etc.)

[Qualcomm] It is controlled user environment in that the tablets are only distributed to specific individuals who agree to the terms and conditions. It is expected that the majority of usage will be in an indoor environment.

3. Type of antenna and gain

[Qualcomm] PIFA antennas with 2dBi antenna gain. The EIRP will be compliant with Part 22/24/27 maximum EIRP limits.

4. Aggregation of signal (maximum number of tablets in a local geographic area)

[Qualcomm] The location is not controlled. Although a maximum of 300 units will be distributed, it is not expected that they will be clustered in close proximity.
