- (5) All of the experimental devices will be under control of Qualcomm Technologies, Inc. and they will be retrieved by Qualcomm Technologies, Inc. from the participants upon completion of the experiment.
- (6) Qualcomm Technologies, Inc. will be responsible for ensuring that the devices are used in authorized locations and in a manner authorized.
- (7) Qualcomm Technologies, Inc. should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
