This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Operation must be in consent of the Advanced Wireless Services (AWS) licensees prior to accessing to 2180-2290 MHz
- (4) Coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers (SBE) frequency coordinator prior to operation in the proposed frequency bands, except 440-443 MHz and 2390-2416 MHz.
- (5) All paging licensees must be notified in 158 MHz, 159 MHz, and 454 MHz frequencies within 50 miles of the test area.
- (6) Operation not permitted in the bands 162.4875-162.5125 MHz and 608-614 MHz.
- (7) To prevent interference to Coast Guard operations, the following frequencies must be notched:
 - a. M156.8000 +/-8K
 - b. M156.5250 +/- 8K
 - c. M161.9750 +/- 10K
 - d. M162.0250 +/- 10K

Special Conditions:

- (8) All of the devices must be retrieved by RACING RADIOS INC from the participants upon completion of the operation.
