9. GENERAL UNCLASSIFIED DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROCUREMENT

This contract activity is a collaborative research and development agreement jointly entered by US Army Ground Vehicle Systems Center (GVSC) (formerly known as TARDEC) and Rada Technologies LLC to develop a Modular Active Protection Systems (MAPS) compliant

Radar system to provide multi-mission capabilities to the US Army in the areas of Active Protection, Counter Unmanned Aerial Systems (C-UAS), ground surveillance, and situational awareness (SA). The radar technology that is being modified for MAPS compliance is imported by RADA Technologies LLC from Israel, from their parent company RADA Electronics Industries Ltd. Aspects of the radar technology that are being developed under this effort are classified at a SECRET level. Additionally, certain requirements levied by the US Army GVSC for this project are classified at a SECRET US ONLY (or SECRET NOFORN) level.

2. Contract facility identified above in item 6.a. as the Prime contract facility and performance location, must be a cleared facility with safeguarding capabilities IAW the NISPOM in order to receive, store, and generate classified information and material.
