Use of frequencies under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA New England Coordinator, Burlington, MA, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.

- (3) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE); ATTN: Executive Director; 9247 North Meridian Street, Suite 305; Indianapolis, IN 46260; telephone, (866) 632-4222; FAX, (317) 846-9120; e-mail, executivedir@sbe.org; information, www.sbe.org.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (6) Licensee should get secure consent from the Advanced Wireless Services licensees in the immediate geographic area prior to operating on the 1610-1754 MHz and 1851-2000 MHz bands.
- (7) Licensee should coordinate with the Fixed Microwave licenses prior to operating on the 4000-4999 MHz, 5650-8000 MHz and 12-16 GHz bands.
- (8) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Mr. John Maciel at (978) 799-1782.
- (9) Operation in the band 2000-2690 MHz requires to further coordination with HQ USAF Frequency Coordinator in Alexandria, VA., to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (10) Operation is NOT permitted on the frequency band; 608-614 MHz due to cause harmful interference to Medical Telemetry.
