Radiance Technologies has requested an experimental license grant from the Office of Engineering and Technology for the purpose of testing and validation of a radar system designed to detect and track vehicles, personnel, and low-flying aircraft. This effort is funded by the US Space and Missile Defense Command (SMDC) under contract number: W9113M-04-C-0066. The nature of the research and its applicability to both military and homeland security is apparent. The focus of the program is the development of man-transportable threat and intrusion detection systems encompassing a gamete of sensing technologies such as: acoustic, seismic, electromagnetic, visual, infrared, etc. The goal of the radar system, in this instance, is to provide detection and confirmation of the presence of objects of interest. The device under test consists of a single microwave transceiver assembled from commercially available off-the-shelf parts.
