Radiance Technologies has requested an experimental license grant from the Office of Engineering and Technology for the purpose of testing and validation of a radar system designed to detect and track high velocity, small caliber ballistic projectiles. This effort is funded by the US Space and Missile Defense Command (SMDC) under contract number: DASG60-99-0009. The nature of the research and its applicability to both military and homeland security efforts requires that the information pertaining to the development of this project remain confidential. The focus of the program is the development of man-transportable threat and intrusion detection systems encompassing a gamete of sensing technologies such as: acoustic, seismic, electromagnetic, visual, infrared, etc. The goal of the radar system, in this instance, is to provide confirmation of detection for high velocity projectiles, whether in fixed site surveillance or mobile, vehicle mounted applications.
