Request for Waiver

RavenWing, Inc. (“RavenWing”) holds experimental license, call sign WD2XYG. RavenWing herein requests a waiver of Section 5.79 of the Commission’s rules in order to secure Commission approval for the transfer of control of RavenWing following the consummation of the subject transaction.

On January 4, 2008, control of RavenWing was transferred to The Boeing Company (“Boeing”) pursuant to a stock acquisition. The normal due diligence process that proceeded the transaction determined that RavenWing did not hold any FCC licenses that are maintained and documented through the FCC’s Universal Licensing System (“ULS”). Due to an inadvertent error, however, the due diligence process failed to confirm that RavenWing holds an experimental license issued by the Office of Engineering and Technology.

Within weeks following consummation of the transaction, Boeing’s Frequency Management Services division, through communications with RavenWing staff, determined that the experimental license did exist. RavenWing filed this application immediately thereafter.

Grant of the requested waiver would serve the public interest. RavenWing is a highly specialized provider of information technology and professional services to government customers. RavenWing is employing its experimental license to develop software and software-based communications solutions that operate using the global infrastructure of existing GSM networks using specially-designed GSM handsets.
