Two questions.

1.) I am assuming the applicant is using the same antenna that is in their current Part 25 licenses (such as SES-LIC-20060629-01083) based on the description. Please confirm.

Regarding 0204-EX-PL-2008, the average EIRP density in 4 kHz calculates to 13.1171 dBW/4 kHz. These exceed the Maximum EIRP density in the Part 25 license which has a maximum EIRP density of 9.38 dBW/4kHz.

2.) What demonstration does the applicant provide to ensure that adjacent satellites do not receive harmful interference?
