Couple questions related to 0295-EX-PL-2006.

1. To simplify application and coordination, is it possible to modify 0295-EX-PL-2006 to show no emissions on the frequencies listed in items 2 and 3 of your email of 20 Oct 2006 (see attached)? Thus, eliminating the need to coordinate with AFTRCC and FAA. Our activity will not be adversely affected if we do not transmit on those channels.

2. My application shows 24 months as estimated duration of the experiment. I now believe that our work will extend beyond 24 months. Should I modify the application to reflect that change in duration?
