Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Avoid transmissions in the direction of the Green Bank Telescope for operation at Wallops Island, VA--approximately +/- 10 degrees from 280 degrees CW from north in azimuth--unless transmission are in a >45 degree down tilt from horizontal.
- (4) If condition #3 is not feasible, provide notification of dates and times of operation to Jonathan Williams (jonwilli@nsf.gov) and Bevin Zauderer (bezauder@nsf.gov).
