2320 - 2345 MHz.

Mr. Mauldin,

I am outside counsel to Sirius XM, and Jim Blitz asked me to respond to your inquiry below regarding Raytheon's request for an experimental STA. Sirius XM has reviewed the request and is unwilling to consent to the proposed operations.

Raytheon is seeking authority for operations near Fullerton, CA in the licensed Sirius XM spectrum at 2320-2345 MHz. The 20 kilometer radius of operations is part of the greater Los Angeles-Anaheim-Santa Ana metroplex and covers many populated areas and busy highways and interstates. At the power levels set forth in the application, Sirius XM believes that the intended experimental operations would cause service outages for the many Sirius XM subscribers who reside in or travel through this area.

Given these concerns, Sirius XM asks that Raytheon notch out the 2320-2345 MHz frequencies from the STA request. Please let us know if you have questions.
