I am sending this application to renew our Special Temporary Authorization (STA) **WA9XDC**, file # **0106-EX-ST-2000** that expires the 27th of August. Along with this request, I have enclosed a \$45 check to the FCC, a copy of our current STA (WA9XDC), and a completed 159 form. The reason that this request is submitted early is that I am retiring 5 July 2000 and want to clear all immediate items.

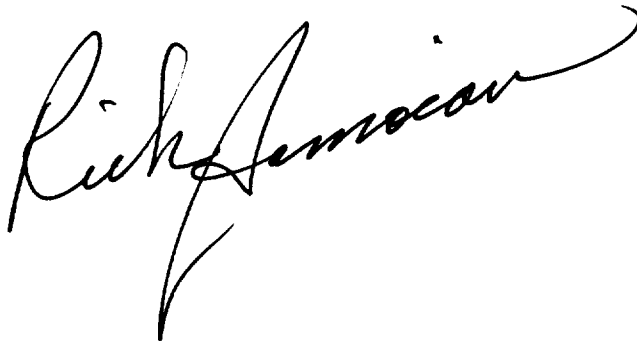
This STA will be used to support necessary testing and continued development of radar programs at the Raytheon Company. This license is necessary for the Raytheon Electronics Systems to meet its government and commercial contract requirements and to develop future radar and antenna hardware.

It is important to note that the test frequency range, power level/modulation and locations all remain as shown on the existing STA. No changes have been made since the initial request, and, to our knowledge, no interference complaints have been received.
