Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.

Special Conditions:

- (4) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (5) Licensee must avoid pointing the transmitting antenna main beam gain within 10 degrees of any point on the geostationary orbital arc while transmitting signals in the 37.5-38 GHz band.
- (6) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.
- (7) No automatic renewal for operations in the 37.5-38 GHz band.
- (8) Prior to operation, the applicant must coordinate with stations authorized to operate in these frequency bands that are located within a 25 mile radius of the transmitter.
