Special Conditions:

- (1) This frequency assignment in one of the bands 1435-1525, 2310-2320 and 2345-2390 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the Area Frequency Coordinator, Ft. Huachuca, AZ, who also coordinated it, as appropriate, with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council. Use of this frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the AFC, Ft. Huachuca, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (2) Operation requires consent of affected Educational Broadband Service/Broadband Radio Service (EBS/BRS) licensees.
- (3) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the Associated Public Safety Communications Officers, Inc. (APCO); ATTN: Director of Frequency Coordination; 351 North Williamson Blvd.; Daytona Beach, FL 32114-1112; Telephone: (386) 322-2500.
- (4) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (5) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.

Special Conditions:

- (6) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (7) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE); ATTN: Executive Director; 9102 North Meridian Street, Suite 305; Indianapolis, IN 46260; telephone, (866) 632-4222; FAX, (317) 846-9120; e-mail, executivedir@sbe.org; information, www.sbe.org.
- (8) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (9) FirstNet can request the FCC to order the licensee to cease operations within 24 hours.
- (10) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by U.S. Navy Contract number: N00019-87-C-3102. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (11) Stop buzzer is Tom Fagan at (520) 465-7087 and (520) 794-0227 to terminate transmissions if interference occurs.
- (12) Assignment in frequency bands 960-1400, and 2000-18000 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the FAA Western Coordinator, Los Angeles, CA. Use of frequencies under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA Western Coordinator, Los Angeles, CA, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (13) The transmission is LIMITED to antenna height of no more than 10 ft AGL, and the direction of 237 degrees referenced to True North and at 70 nsec per pulse.
- (14) Subject to coordination with the Area Frequency Coordinator, located at the Army Electronic Proving Ground, Ft. Huachuca, Arizona, prior to use within the State of Arizona. Phone: 520-538-6423.
- (15) Operations on 1300 MHz will be in accordance with the following: PRR = 100K pps, pulse duration = 0.05-0.1 us.
- (16) Successfully secure consents from the existing and future Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensees.
- (17) Maintain separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, sub-part Z, or coordinate and agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3650-3700 MHz.
- (18) Ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz, and notify the registered users in the proposed area.
