- (4) Operation is limited to activity for the purpose of testing radionavigation satellite service (RNSS) equipment and systems.
- (5) GPS users in the area of potential interference to GPS reception must be notified that GPS information may be impacted for periods of time.
- (6) EIRP is no greater than -141 dbm at 20 meter.
- (7) This license SUPERSEDES the previously issued license with the same call sign and file number: amend conditions.
