Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (4) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (5) Raytheon Missile Systems must coordinate with the ARO during the initial tests, to confirm no adverse interference to the Arizona Radio Observatory (ARO).

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Special Conditions:

- (6) Raytheon Missile Systems coordinate the operation with the existing users in 92-95 GHz band in the testing area prior to commencing the experimental operations.
