Special Conditions:

- (1) Subject to coordination with the Area Frequency Coordinator located at White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico, prior to use in the State of New Mexico or other U. S. Territory within a 150 mile radius of WSMR plus the area of Utah and Colorado that lies South of 41 degrees North and between 108 degrees and 111 degrees West. Phone: 505-678-5417 or 3702.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (5) Operations MUST, repeat MUST, be scheduled with AFC-WSMR, at least 96 hours prior to operations, via e-mail to usarmy.wsmr.imcomcentral. list.dodafc@mail.mil. AFC-WSMR will schedule the Raytheon operations in the Integrated Frequency De-confliction System (IFDS). Should IFDS show a conflict, AFC-WSMR reserves the right to have Raytheon stand down their operations until the conflict is resolved - either by Raytheon operating on another frequency listed in paragraph 1 or by Raytheon waiting until the DoD operations have completed.
