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Frequency Information

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Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 27.5-29.5 GHz and 38.6-40 GHz bands in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d).
- (4) Further requests for extension of the authority granted herein must be filed on Form 442, "Application for New or Modified Radio Station Authorization under Part 5 of FCC Rules - Experimental Radio Service." Future STA requests to extend this authorization will not be considered.
- (5) The authorized station must be in compliance with environmental requirement set forth in Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules.
- (6) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (7) The fixed station antenna(s) main beam elevation angle is at (Zero degree) or below the horizon (below Zero degrees) while transmitting signals in the 37.5-41 GHz band.
