Exhibit 1 – Explanation of Request for Transfer of Control

Raytheon Company, headquartered in Waltham, Massachusetts, is a defense contractor that builds products for agencies of the federal government, approved foreign purchasers, state and local governments, and the commercial private sector. Its products often include advanced radio systems, which have been developed by laboratories within Raytheon's various divisions and subsidiaries.

Transferor:

Raytheon Network Centric Systems (NCS) was one of 6 business units owned by Raytheon Company. In 2013 Raytheon consolidated the six business units to four. Parts of NCS transferred to Raytheon Space and Airborne Systems while the remaining departments were split between other Raytheon divisions. Raytheon NCS is the transferor on this application.

Reason for Transfer and Licenses to Transfer:

Raytheon Company, in an effort to establish a better spectrum management processes and procedures for the whole company is working to consolidate its license holdings under the four FCC Registration Numbers (FRNs) of its four main operating divisions. Raytheon Space and Airborne Systems (SAS) is one of those four divisions.

Grant of this Transfer of Control application will help Raytheon Company to be sure that its Raytheon SAS Business Spectrum Manager is responsible for licensing compliance for this license as well as the other licenses used in the operations of the business.

This is a request to transfer control of the license listed here:

Transferee – Raytheon Space and Airborne Systems:

The proposed transfer of control will move the licenses from the name and FRN of Raytheon NCS to the FRN of the division that Raytheon branch of NCS was transferred to works under – Raytheon Space and Airborne Systems.

There is no change to the ultimate parent company, nor to the de facto control of the license. However, the filing is appropriate because Raytheon is requesting authority to change the legal business entity that actually holds the license.
