Dear John F. Adams,

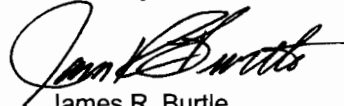
This refers to application, File No. 0441-EX-ST-2010, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. This application was dismissed based on the following reasons:

1. Per NTIA the requested band is primarily for Radar use and not for disaster communications. There are numerous operations that will cause interference to this operation and also receive interference. The equipment needs to be developed in a fixed and mobile band.
2. The Air Force objects for the same reason but also adds that if this is for a federal program, the requester needs to include the contract number.
