This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation in the 1695-1780 MHz, 1915-1920 MHz, 1995-2020 MHz or 2110-2200 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Obtain consents from the Broadband Radio Service licensees prior to operation in 2496- 2500 MHz band.
- (5) Coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator and the affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 2450-2500 MHz band.

Special Conditions:

- (7) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (8) Operations in the WCS bands (2310-2320 MHz and 2345-2360 MHz) must comply with the emission limits applicable to those bands. See 47 C.F.R. § 27.53(a).
- (9) Prior to commencing any operations in WCS (2310-2320 MHz/2345-2360 MHz) frequencies, the applicant must obtain consent from the WCS licensee (AT&T).
- (10) Raytheon SAS must coordinate/de-conflict any transmission on 1800 MHz with their EOD team:
