- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (5) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.

- (7) Due to auxiliary broadcast stations within 20 km of the reported geographical coordinates, operation is subject to prior coordination with the Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. - (8) Licensee must coordinate with Fixed Point to Point and Multiple Address System licensees.
- (9) No operation is permitted in D-Block public safety bands 758-769 MHz and 788-799 MHz.
- (10) Operation is subject to prior coordination with incumbent FM licensees in 88-100 MHz band.
