Subject: Application for Special Temporary Authorization, Nr. 0034-EX-ST-2010

Purpose of Operation. Raytheon requests a STA in support of Factory Acceptance Testing for Electronic Scan Antennas at Towson, MD, and Largo, FL. The STA will enable Raytheon to meet the requirements of Department of the Navy's Zumwalt Program Contract Number N00024-05-C5346, as well as Department of the Air Force's F-15 Program Contract Number PO 226262 (Raytheon is subcontractor to Boeing).
Explanation. Raytheon will be conducting evaluation and Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) for deliverable IFF electronic Scan Antennas, ensuring through the FAT process that new antennas are capable of performing to specifications outlined in the contract. Evaluation and FAT testing will include antenna pattern and antenna gain measurements.
