Special Conditions:

- (4) Operations must be scheduled as a WSMR Range Mission, through the appropriate Range Sponsor. Final authorization to radiate is contingent upon successful scheduling of spectrum, and airspace, with other area operations. The final operating frequency, or frequencies, shall be determined by the WSMR Spectrum Manager, in coordination with the WSMR Range Sponsor, and is dependent on the RF environment, at the time of test.
