Mr. Barry Hackworth,

This application is still being processed and will not be completed before the Start Date, April 25, 2008. Do you concur to changing the Start Date and End Date? If so, please report the new Start Date and End Date (allowing at least one to two weeks for processing preceding the new Start Date).

Also, the frequency 149 MHz falls within a shared Federal/Non-Federal government frequency band. NTIA has mandated that all Federal government departments and agencies must transition from wideband (25 kHz bandwidth) to narrowband (less than 12.5 kHz) operating frequencies within the bands 138-144 MHz and 148-150.8 MHz. Accordingly, please report a new bandwidth that is less than 12.5 kHz.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of April 24, 2008 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
