Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee must accept interference from others operating in the band and must not cause interference to FirstNet operations or those approved to operate in Band 14 per license (i.e. AT&T testing or public safety entities authorized to operate on Band 14).
- (2) Licensee POC shall submit a "Stop Buzzer" contact to FirstNet at peter.tomczak@firstnet.gov upon authorization issuance with "kill switch" authority; license POC agrees to immediately cease operations on Band 14 if notified of any interference concerns until any issues are resolved.
- (3) Licensee agrees that this license may be subject to further review by the FCC and possible re-coordination with FirstNet.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (6) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (7) NTIA objects to the use of the following frequencies (in GHz w/27 MHz bandwidth):
15.15875; 15.22375; 15.33375. 21.4250; 21.6250; 22.6250; 22.8250; 23.3750
- (8) Raytheon should be aware that government handheld radios operate in Long Beach, CA. Special attention should be given to avoid causing interference to the following frequencies:
318 MHz; 342 MHz; 413.200 MHz; 413.225 MHz; 413.250 MHz; 413.275 MHz;
413.300 MHz; 413.325 MHz; 413.350 MHz; 413.375 MHz; 413.400 MHz
- (9) Due to low power TV bands below 2 GHz, operation is subject to prior coordination with the Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE); ATTN: Executive Director; 9247 North Meridian Street, Suite 305; Indianapolis, IN 46260; telephone, (866) 632-4222; FAX, (317) 846-9120; e-mail, executivedir@sbe.org; information, www.sbe.org.

Special Conditions:

- (10) Scheduling required for each usage with Western Area Frequency Coordinator, Tel: (805) 989-1003 or (805) 989-7985, prior to EDWARDS AFB and CHINA LAKE, CA operations.
- (11) Operation is subject to prior coordination with affected existing Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).
- (12) Licensee need to secure consent from the Advance Wireless Services licensees prior to operation on 1710-2000 MHz band.
- (13) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by government contract numbers: N00019-05-G-0008 and N68936-05-D-0033. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (14) No operation PERMITTED in 410.2875-410.3125 MHz and 413.1-413.125 bands.
- (15) No operation PERMITTED in 335.425-406 MHz and 1610 - 1645.5 MHz bands.
