- (5) All operations within test range R2508 must be coordinated.
- (6) Operation in 412th Test Wing must be prior coordinated with Mr. James Littlefield at (661) 277-4763, 24 hours prior to testing.
- (7) The authorized station must be in compliance with environmental requirement set forth in Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules.
