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Special Conditions:

- (1) Subject to coordination with the Area Frequency Coordinator located at White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico, prior to use in the State of New Mexico or other U. S. Territory within a 150 mile radius of WSMR plus the area of Utah and Colorado that lies South of 41 degrees North and between 108 degrees and 111 degrees West. Phone: 505-678-5417 or 3702.
- (2) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (3) This frequency assignment was coordinated prior to authorization with FAA Headquarters, 800 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, DC 20591; Telephone: 202-267-8699.
- (4) Operation on frequency assignments in one of the bands 1435-1535 or 2310-2390 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the Western Area Frequency Coordinator (WAFC), Point Mugu, CA, who also coordinated it, as appropriate, with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council. Use of this frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the WAFC as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (5) Operation requires consent of affected Educational Broadband Service/Broadband Radio Service (EBS/BRS) licensees.
- (6) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.

Special Conditions:

- (7) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (8) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (9) Operation in the 1695-1780 MHz, 1915-1920 MHz, 1995-2020 MHz or 2110-2200 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
