VIDEO PRODUCTION FOR CONGRESSIONAL CUP SAILING REGATTA

NARRATIVE AND FREQUENCY COORDINATION EXHIBIT

The purpose of this experimental operation is to conduct video production activities in support of a premier, large-scale United States sailing regatta. The instant application proposes STA operation for a United Kingdom-based video and audio production and broadcasting company. Similar STA operations for this purpose have been granted continuously by the Commission since 2012. See, e.g. WJ9XIZ, File No. 1343-EX-ST-2015. No interference has ever been reported at these international sailing regattas.

The event is the Congressional Cup, founded by the Long Beach Yacht Club in 1965 and hosted by the Yacht Club continually, to the present time. It is the inaugural event annually of modern world-class match sailboat racing: the premier and longest running event of its kind in North America. The event will be held at Long Beach, California, at a course just offshore from the Belmont Pier in Long Beach, and within a radius of one mile of the Pier. The dates are April 27 to May 3, 2020, inclusive.

The applicant is experienced at large-event video production and will have sufficient staff on site to avoid interference and ensure local frequency coordination.

The application proposes the use of commercial RF cameras located on chase boats offshore near the course, in the range of 2 GHz; and UHF radio talkback mobiles in the band 440-450 MHz.

All of the RF devices will be under the control of Red Handed Television, Ltd. at all times. This authorization is requested for the express purpose of conducting video production operations described in the application and herein. There will be no other use of this authorization in any other manner or for any other purpose. The facilities proposed will not be operated after the expiration date of the STA. The total number of RF video production devices and UHF transceivers shall not exceed 40. Red Handed Television will be responsible for ensuring that the devices are used only in authorized location and only in the manner authorized. Red Handed Television is aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the facilities will be subject to immediate shut down and operation will not recommence unless and until the interference is resolved to the satisfaction of all licensees.

All use of the 2 GHz BAS band will be coordinated in advance with the SBE market frequency coordinator, and channels in the 440-450 MHz band will be selected so as to avoid

Amateur Radio repeater inputs and outputs in the area and by prior monitoring of channels to avoid those in use. No public safety channels will be utilized at all. The band 2360-2395 MHz will be coordinated in advance through AFTRCC whose coordination is being requested now. AFTRCC consent will be filed when received.
