Alda Tucson, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sprint Nextel Corporation (collectively "Sprint Nextel") is the licensee of Broadband Radio Service ("BRS") Station WNTJ881. Station WNTJ881 has a service area covering Las Vegas, Nevada on Channel H3 (2674 – 2680 MHz).

Sprint Nextel hereby concurs with the associated request for Experimental Special Temporary Authority ("STA") filed by Redline Communications ("Redline"). Redline requests the STA to allow for operations on Broadband Radio Service Channel H3 during the Interop Las Vegas 2007 IT Conference and Expo scheduled from May 22, 2007 through May 24, 2007 at the Mandalay Bay Resort and Casino, 3950 Las Vegas Boulevard South, Las Vegas, Nevada. Redline will operate with an EIRP under 1 milliwatt for internal purposes only. Sprint Nextel and Redline will coordinate their respective operations on Channel H3 to ensure there is no interference to either party.
