SAVI Technology is a developer and manufacture of radio frequency tags and asset tracking systems. Savi radio tags and interrogators are currently in the process of being approved for unlicensed operation in compliance with Part 15 of FCC rules (pending FCC IDs KL7-INT-315-V2, KL7-TYTAG-315-V1).

SAVI Technology is investigating the feasibility of remote operation of their asset tracking system. This research involves the remote operation of the SAVI asset management computer system utilizing two Trimble Navigation Galaxy Inmarsat-C/GPS satellite earth stations (TNL 7001 Maritime Inmarsat-C SES).

These two Inmarsat satellite earth stations will be utilized to transmit and receive computer control messages, GPS position data, and simulated asset related parameters between two remote locations. The test process will evolve from the operation of the two earth station terminals at the same location, for proof of concept, to the operation of one terminal at a remote location approximately 40 miles from the SAVI Technology R&D facility.

The Inmarsat-C satellite earth station has been chosen because it is an off-the-shelf commercially proven technology, provides world wide system connectivity independent of other communication infrastructures, and incorporates a self contained GPS geo-location system.
