Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Robert Bosch LLC shall coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator prior to operation in 2400-2483.5 MHz band.
- (4) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (5) All of the experimental devices be retrieved by Robert Bosch LLC from the participants upon completion of the operation.

- (7) Robert Bosch LLC shall secure consents from the Advanced Wireless Service licensees prior to accessing to 1710-1755 MHz and 2110-2155 MHz bands.
- (8) Robert Bosch LLC shall coordinate with Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in the frequency range from 2450 to 2483.5 MHz in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d).

Special Conditions:

- (9) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, the applicant must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
- 700 MHz Lower Band “A” block licensees (698-704 MHz/728-734 MHz)
 - 700 MHz Lower Band “B” block licensees (704-710 MHz/734-740 MHz)
 - 700 MHz Lower Band “C” block licensees (710-716 MHz/740-746 MHz)
 - 700 MHz Upper Band “C” block (746-757 MHz/776-787 MHz) licensee (Verizon and/or lessees)
 - Cellular licensees (824-849 MHz/869-894 MHz)
 - Broadband PCS licensees (1850-1910 MHz/1930-1990 MHz)
