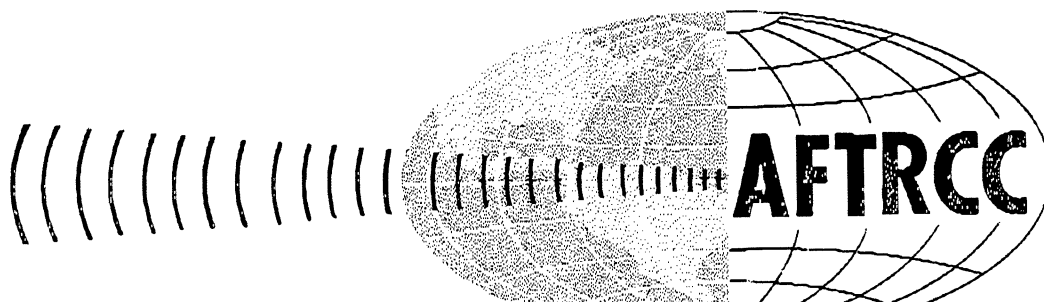

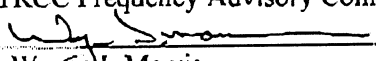
AFTRCC concurs with your request for renewal of Special Temporary Authorization for (WA9XDY) for VHF data link testing during the period March 1 – August 30, 2001. This is a renewal of a previously coordinated STA.

Type(s) of operation(s) – Aeronautical Mobile and Fixed Base
Location: Melbourne FL. and 150 mirad
Period of operations: March 1 – August 30, 2001
Frequency(ies): M123.425 (in conjunction with M123.475-KMC6)
Emission(s): 13K0A2D / 14K0G1DE
Power: 30 watts both fixed and aeronautical mobile
Restrictions: Aircraft is limited to flight level 10,000 and below during data link testing.
