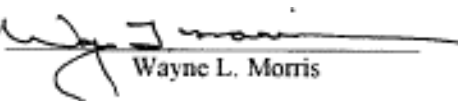
Testing will be accomplished in conjunction with current license(s) KMC6 and N2O6PD.
