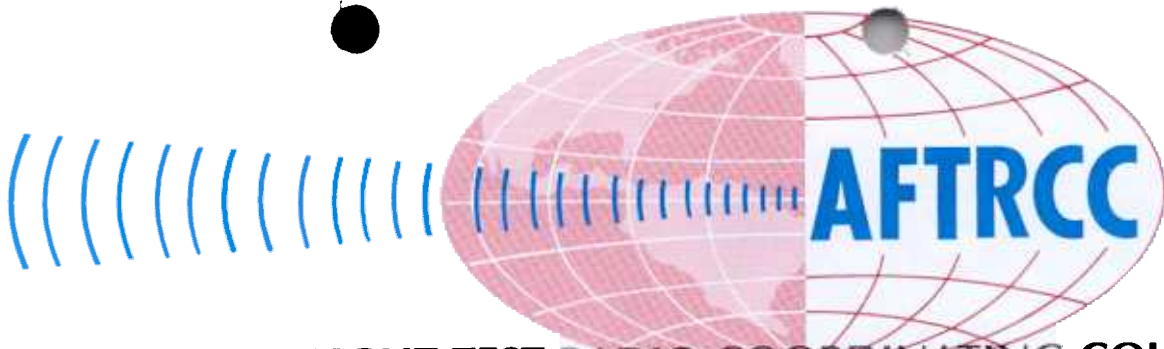

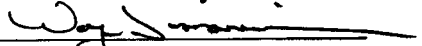
Type(s) of operation(s) – FX, MO
Location – Melbourne FL. and 242 KM
Period of operation – 1 March – 30 August 2002
Frequency(ies) - M123.425 (in conjunction with M123.475-KMC6)
Emission(s) – 14K0G1D / 13K0A2D
ERP – 30 watts both fixed and mobile
Restrictions: Aircraft is limited to flight level 10,000 and below during data link testing.
