Reference: Experimental Licenses KM2XLB, KM2XLC, *Cancelled* K02XBR AND K02XGS

Gentlemen:

Application is made herewith on FCC Forms 442 for modification of three of the above four licenses. Additional frequencies are requested common to all licences, and authorization is requested to increase the area of mobile operation to U.S. wide for K02XGS, currently authorized for the area Washington, DC to Boston, Mass. If this action is granted, the mobile licence K02XBR, which authorizes operation on the west coast, San Francisco to Los Angeles, could be cancelled consequentially as long as the area of operation would be covered by K02XGS if authorized for operation U.S. wide. Also, an improved antenna is planned for the mobile operation.

Results of the test program to date have been encouraging, accordingly, your early consideration in this matter would be appreciated to permit our expanding the program as soon as possible.
