Dear Mr. Wright:

On behalf of Ron Abboud and pursuant to Section 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, it is requested that the April 9, 1993 progress report for Experimental Station KI2XAD, forwarded to you via facsimile per your request on October 4, 1994 (a copy of which is attached for your convenience), remain confidential and not be made available for public inspection. This request is based upon the commercial nature of the information in the progress report and Section 0.457(d) of the Commission's Rules which authorizes the Commission to withhold from public inspection "... materials which would not customarily be released to the public" by the person requesting confidentiality. The information in the progress report is not information that Mr. Abboud would make public.

The progress report for Experimental Station KI2XAD contains specific information concerning the operation of the station which could prove to be beneficial to potential competitors in the Omaha market who have not expended the money to gain such benefits. It also could be used by competing technologies, such as cable television, in their efforts to compete with wireless cable. Accordingly, until the experiment is completed, other licensees and applicants should not be permitted access to information concerning Mr. Abboud's experimental operation.

For this reason, we respectfully request that the April 9, 1993 progress report for Experimental Station KI2XAD be kept confidential and not made available for public inspection.
