We might be able to grant you an experimental license for all of these proposed frequencies for a short period of time. However, by looking at the NPRM if there is a service rule implemented in near future, you would have to cease operation for those frequencies that are not part of the rule. And if you are conducting equipment testing and research, it may not be a good investment idea to utilize frequencies that they will not be allowed for that particular technology.

In addition, please explain for use of a 60-month experimental license as opposed to a 24-month experimental license.
