Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (2) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (3) Operation requires consent of affected Educational Broadband Service/Broadband Radio Service (EBS/BRS) licensees.
- (4) Operation in the 824-849 or 869-894 MHz band requires consent of local cellular licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (5) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at http://freq.sbe.org/pdf_files/coordinators.pdf to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (6) The licensee must consult the ULS database to ensure that the proposed operation will not cause adverse effect to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band and notify registered users in the immediate geographic area.
- (7) S2 Corp must notify Paging and General Aviation Air Ground licensees in 454-455 and 459-460 MHz, serving the test area.
- (8) Licensee must get the consent of all 700 MHz Band licensees (698-788 MHz) within 40 km of the test area.
- (9) Licensee must notify the Commercial Air-Ground licensee, Gogo (849-851 MHz/894-896 MHz).
- (10) Licensee must notify Narrowband PCS licensees (901-902 MHz).
- (11) Licensee must notify the 1670-1675 MHz Band licensee.
- (12) Licensee must coordinate with the existing users prior to operation in 71-76 GHz, 81-86 GHz and 92-95 GHz bands.
- (13) Operation in the 1695-1780, 1915-1920, 1995-2020 or 2110-2200 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
