Your application mentions that your testing will be used to support a government contract and names the agency that the contract is for as Office of Naval Research, yet there is no real contract number. If you wish to have this application considered as supporting a government contract, we will need a contract number and a government point of contact, with phone number, who can verify the contract. Sometimes it helps speed approval of access to federal government spectrum if there is a verifiable government contract, but it isn't necessarily needed to get permission to use that spectrum. Let me know if you want me to coordinate this as a non-contract experiment.
