Downlink (Beacon) 437.290 MHz (same as Copper)

We have noted with interest the S (Non amateur spectrum) operation

You have indicated the launch date as 15 October 2013. Please let us know when you have the final date

Please note that all frequencies in the amateur satellite service are shared frequencies. We have attempted to make the best possible selection for your project.
