There are several end objectives of the Coastal Ocean Currents Monitoring Program (COCMP). In short, COCMP funding is provided by the State of California to help monitor and manage coastal water quality in California. A major asset in attaining this goal is to establish operational use of High-Frequency Radar (HFR) to monitor coastal and bay surface currents. These systems, once operational, will provide a wealth of benefits including tracking oil spills, monitoring sewage outfalls, help manage fisheries, etc. Many of these benefits are explained in detail on the website: <http://cocmp.org>.

The funding for COCMP is granted through 2010, therefore the requested FCC license is for 48 months.
